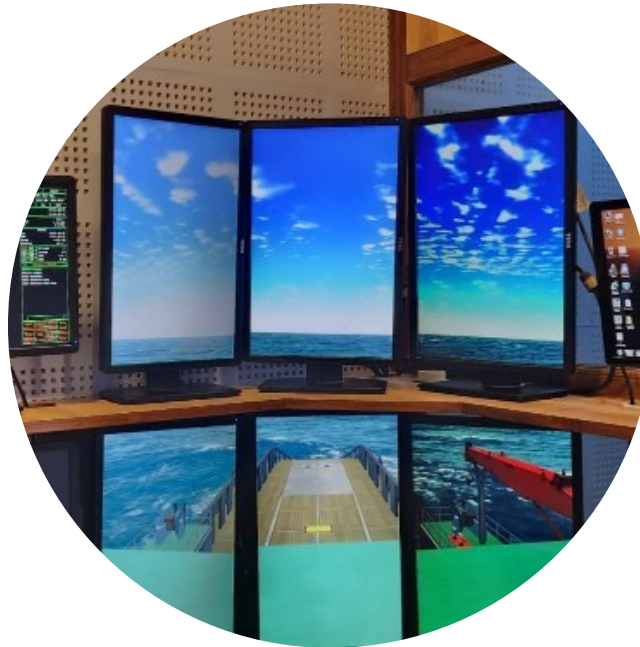

The training courses related to Dynamic Positioning (DP) offered by the training centre consist of different modules tailored to specific needs. Here's an overview of each course:

1. **Induction Course:** The Induction Course primarily focuses on theoretical instruction with guided practical exercises. Trainees are introduced to various DP operational modes. The practical aspect of the course utilizes a DP system installed in the training center and incorporates a level of simulation on ARI Class C Simulator. This course provides trainees with a foundational understanding of DP operations.
2. **Simulation Course:** The Simulation Course is centered around practical exercises conducted on ARI Class B Simulators. Theory is also included to familiarize trainees with different DP operations and principles. This course offers hands-on experience in simulated DP scenarios, allowing trainees to apply their knowledge and enhance their skills.
3. **Revalidation Course:** The Revalidation Course is designed for individuals who already hold a DPO Certificate from the NI (Nautical Institute) but require revalidation due to insufficient DP sea time. The primary objective of this course is to update DPOs with the latest rules and regulations, position references and sensors, as well as share information about known DP incidents and lessons learned. The course incorporates practical exercises conducted on ARI Class B Simulators, along with theory sessions to refresh the DPOs' understanding of various DP operations and principles.
